The following criteria have been established as guidelines in the selection of the BOAC grant award: <ul style="list-style-type: none">(A) The project must be worthwhile to a broad segment of the agricultural community.(B) The BOAC application should be based on community projects to improve the facilities, grounds, or buildings, which are used by various groups or organizations in the area to include school-owned land and/or property.(C) Only Missouri 4-H clubs are eligible to participate. 4-H councils, county junior leader organizations, and Clover Kids are excluded.(D) This application can only be used for 4-H BOAC projects.(E) Include a letter of recommendation from a community leader to validate the project. <p style="text-align: center;">Do not include any attachments – they will not be judged!</p>
